The applicant agrees that they have explored all alternative options for planting required trees on site and have exhausted all alternatives. The applicant agrees to provide site plans and landscape plans to the Urban Forester showing justification for entering the tree mitigation bank. The applicant agrees to pay the City of Knoxville to plant trees in an alternative location on public grounds or rights-of-way that are comparable to the trees or landscaping otherwise required on site by the City Code. The applicant agrees to pay a one-time, flat cost for the planting and maintenance of such comparable trees. The flat cost for planting and maintenance of comparable trees is three times the base price for the City to purchase and plant the comparable tree. Payment for the tree mitigation bank will be a one-time flat cost. Due to the ongoing maintenance that will be required by the City of Knoxville for the life of the tree, the flat cost is three times the base price. The current price to purchase and plant a tree in the tree mitigation bank is posted on the City of Knoxville Urban Forestry website. The applicant agrees to pay the City the current tree mitigation price for each tree that the applicant is unable to plant. Agreeing to pay into the bank does not exempt the applicant from other landscape code requirements not covered in this application.
