City residents produced $\mathbf{1 3 5 , 4 1 6}$ tons of waste this past year.
Here is the 2023 breakdown of disposal types by weight:

Knoxville remains well below the national average recycling rate, but we continue to make significant progress in the amount of yard waste that is kept out of the landfill and is instead repurposed into mulch.
