# KNOXVILLE TREE BOARD MEETING MINUTES SEPTEMBER 2, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Dale Madden at 8:35 am. Other board members present were Tom Welborn, Craig Walker, Nick Bridgeman, Robert Graves, Natalia Almonacid, Andrew Caylor, Daniel Steinhoff, and Charles Kwit.

Ex-Officio members present were Kasey Krouse, Ben Nanny, Diane Warwick, and Jeanne Stevens.

Visiting this month is Charley Batey.

## **Action Items for September**

- Approve August minutes: Tom Welborn made a motion to approve and it was seconded by Dale Madden.
- Determine interest in committee chairs and confirm Arbor Day event.

### City Update with Kasey Krouse

- Kasey stated they will be doing the nursery visit to pick out trees on September 15<sup>th</sup>.
   They will be finalizing the list later this week.
- In regards to the Tree Ordinance, Chad Weth and Kasey have approached every City Council member and received feedback from them in support.
  - They are looking to push the Ordinance to the agenda, in the next month or so, ideally in October.
- On September 17-19, the ISA southern tree climbing competition will be at Victor Ashe Park.
  - o There will be no international conference.
  - Kasey will send an email out to sign up to volunteer for this event.
- Urban Forestry has been doing a lot of reactive work with storm cleanup. They are behind on work orders but working hard to catch back up.
- They are looking at swapping American elms for Lacebark or Frontier elm as both have a resistance to Dutch-Elm and Elm-yellow disease.

#### Trees Knoxville Update with Tom Welborn

- Tom participated in the TN River Basin virtual meeting.
- Trees Knoxville rewarded a grant for work in Mary Vestal Park with the Riparian restoration.
  - o Received \$4000 for work there.

- Kasey and Tom joined the Tree Committee for Lakeshore Park as they are moving in the Phase 2 of their plan for their ball fields.
  - They are taking down some trees and wanting to plant some to replace and asked Kasey and Tom for input on what to plant.
  - o They plan to ask for Arboretum status afterwards.
  - Natalia Almonacid asked to be included in the next meeting they have with the Tree Committee.
- Kasey and Trees Knoxville are also working with a group in Soddy-Daisy, TN to develop a tree board and a similar non-profit like Trees Knoxville.
  - o Aiming to sit down and talk with them in October.
- The tree walk at Fourth and Gill drew about 20 people.
- Volunteer Forester Level 1 class will be on 10/13. Registration is online and available to all Tree Board members.
- The TUFC annual conference is going to be one conference (was talked about being 3 for each area of TN) and has no date set yet.
  - o Kasey and Trees Knoxville are expected to present the Canopy Assessment.
  - Charley Batey stated that he received confirmation yesterday that they are going to do it virtually.

## **Education Update with Craig Walker**

- No education event is planned for September. Craig is planning to talk to Lee Rumble about doing another event on planting.
- October was possibly Fire Preparedness at Ijams Nature Center.
  - o Ben Nanny has not heard any confirmation on this.
  - Kasey will reach out to Tom Simpson to confirm if this event is still happening and if in-person or virtual.
- November is Arbor Day. Tentatively set for West Hills Park based on location and the canopy assessment.
  - Confirmed with Tim Hester that this location should be work.
  - o This will be on November 5<sup>th</sup>. The time is TBD.
  - Craig will look into inviting at least one class from the elementary school, as well as KUB & UT.
  - o Arbor Day committee needs to meet and develop program for this year.
  - Dale Madden said he would reach out to the principal of the elementary about any classes that might be interested in joining.
  - o Kasey will look into inviting the Mayor and City Council members.
  - Charles Kwit suggested that his students can assist with some of the prep work before November 5<sup>th</sup>.

## Ben Nanny:

- The Fire Safe/Preparedness will possibly be in October.
  - He has not heard any confirmation though.
  - Kasey again said he will reach back out to Tom Simpson to confirm.
- o Ijams hosted the Hummingbird Festival this weekend.
  - Used full campus for in person event- allowing for proper social distancing.
- o Symphony in the Park is now Twilight at Ijams and will be held in 2 weeks.
  - This is their big fundraiser.
- o Ijams has also been dealing with storm damage cleanup.
  - They are behind on several projects and are hoping to catch up on them in October.
  - They have received storm cleanup help from the Appalachian Mountain Bike Club.

#### Jeanne Stevens:

- Taking over Ex-Officio spot for Mike Reynolds.
- Jeanne asked to be included in any meetings or plans regarding the Tree mitigation bank of Gov John Sevier Hwy corridor.
- Jeanne stated that the Knoxville-Knox County Planning is hoping to develop a master plan and recommend developments over the next 15 years.

## • Nick Bridgeman:

- o KUB has been focused on storm cleanup as well.
- o Overall their system held up well with all the storms in the area.
- o KUB has a website to see where crew are actively working on tree maintenance.
- o KUB wants to be involved with Arbor Day again.

#### • Diane Warwick:

- Tree planting grants for the Agriculture Enhancement Program are delayed with getting the contracts out with the signature.
  - November 1<sup>st</sup> date has not changed.
- o Diane thanked Kasey and Tom for helping out the Soddy-Daisy group as they had originally reached out to her first.
  - They've had a lot of development and lost a large swath of trees.
  - Diane suggested a good document for merging development and protecting tree canopy.
- Diane also provided a link to a presentation on using Riparian as a buffer to help with preventing flooding.
  - Diane would be willing to speak on this for an education presentation.
- The TN Department of Agriculture has contracted the state coordinator position through TUFC to Robert Elliott).

# **Committee Assignment Discussion**

- Dale and Kasey encouraged members to be involved in the committees and subcommittees.
  - o Jeanne Stevens asked to be on the Policy and Planning Committee.
  - o Ben Nanny wanted to continue being on the Education Committee.
  - Nick Bridgeman asked to be either on the Policy & Planning Committee or Education Committee depending on which had the greater needs for members.
  - Natalia Almonacid asked to be on the Education committee and on the Policy & Planning Committee.
  - Daniel Steinhoff agreed to serve wherever was most needed.
  - Charles Batey was interested in joining both the Tree Board and then joining the Policy & Planning Committee.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:41 am.
