SUBJECT: Quarterly Administrative Review of A (3 rd Quarter 2015)	Agency Practices Including Citizen Concerns

As required by CALEA Standards and KPD General Orders, the Internal Affairs Unit conducted a quarterly review of bias based profiling issues for the third quarter of 2015. After the review of relevant data and reports, there is no indication that any officer in this department is involved in bias based profiling.

During the third quarter of 2015, the Internal Affairs Unit received no racial profiling complaints. The Internal Affairs Unit will continue to review and aggressively follow-up on any citizen complaints of this nature.

Lisa Chambers of the Police Advisory and Review Committee was contacted regarding citizen complaints that involved bias based profiling. A memo received from her indicated that there was one racial profiling case reviewed by P.A.R.C. during the 3nd quarter of 2015. An investigation of that case determined that the racial profiling did not occur.

A review of the 2014 Recruit Academy curriculum confirmed that all officers are receiving extensive training regarding bias based profiling and diversity issues to include legal aspects, as required by departmental policy. The curriculum for any upcoming Recruit Academy will be reviewed to ensure this practice remains in place.

Additionally, the following data was reviewed:

- Arrests based upon officer encounters (rather than the number of charges)
- Citations issued based upon officer encounters (rather than the number of citations)
- Field Interviews completed
- State Seizures and DAGs

The outcome of this review of bias based profiling indicates that all department personnel have followed policy, as well as guidelines established by CALEA. There are no recommended changes to departmental policy at this time.

Police Advisory and Review Committee (PARC) Biased Based Police Report

07/01/15 – 09/30/15 3rd Quarter

There was one PARC racial profiling case reviewed by the Police Advisory and Review Committee during the 3rd Quarter of 2015.

Case Summary:

The complainant contacted the PARC Office because she believed her cousin was stopped without reason and told to get out of his car, while the Officer had has hand on his gun. The complainant believed the officer racially profiled her cousin when he stopped the car without probable cause.

Outcome:

During the investigation it was noted that the officer knew the person driving the car and knew that he did not have a valid driver's license. The officer verified the driver's license status via NCIC prior to the stop.







3RD QUARTER 2015 CITES - COMPARISION BY AGE






3RD QUARTER 2015 CITES - GENDER / AGE
