IN THE CRIMINAL COURT FOR KNOX COUNTY, TENNESSEE

GRAND JURY FINDINGS

THIS MATTER came before the Grand Jury of Knox County, Tennessee, on December 14, 2023, pursuant to their inquisitorial powers vested by Tennessee Rule of Criminal Procedure 6. After hearing relevant facts and information, the Grand Jury makes the following findings:

- That there is probable cause to believe that Johnny Edgar Warwick committed the offense of First-Degree Murder of Anthony Williams on or about July 7, 1989, in Knox County, Tennessee.
- 2. That Johnny Edgar Warwick died on or about November 1, 2023.

THEREFORE, the Grand Jury of Knox County, Tennessee, finds that Johnny Edgar Warwick, on or about the 7th day of July, 1989, did unlawfully, intentionally, deliberately and with premeditation kill Anthony Williams, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-2-202 (1989) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee, but due to the confirmed death of Johnny Edgar Warwick on or about the 1st day of November, 2023, no criminal proceedings may be pursued against the deceased Warwick.
